SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION

The event wants to bring together the European ITLS Chapters, under the coordination of ITLS Global Development Committee, with the presence of representative of ITLS International Board of Directors in addition to medical specialists, nurses and volunteers, coming from all over Italy, engaged in management of pre-hospital emergency care. The program, structured in a day and a half (Friday afternoon and saturday all day) examines, in particular, the pattern of trauma patient (adult and pediatric) in out of hospital setting, following the ABC diagram. Will also be focused current topics always in continual updating with mass emergencies and new technologies, available on the market, for treatment and support of trauma patients in pre-hospital setting.

In parallel five workshops for the deepening of following topics:

Workshop 1: Capnography

The workshop aims to analyze, both theoretical and practical, the use of capnography in emergency. For 20 peoples (Doctors and Nurses).

Workshop 2: Chest decompression of tension pneumothorax

The Workshop aims to analyze through technical and scientific bases and skill sessions, the technique of decompression of pneumothorax with nursing point of view. Will be analyzed, in addition, medical/legal issues related to this procedure. For 20 Nurses.

Workshop 3: Ecofast

This Workshop provide theoretical knowledge on FAST (Focused Abdominal Sonography for Trauma) ultrasound and practical skills with ECOFAST apparatus. For 20 Doctors.

Workshop 4: ECX2 – Emergency Care For 2

The aims of workshop is provide the necessary know-how for proper management of obstetrics and neonatal out of hospital emergencies, with the various evolutionary scenarios of the emergency itself. From dispatch to hospitalization. For 20 peoples (Doctors, Nurses and Volunteers).

Workshop 5: Spinal Motion Restriction (SMR) and transport of trauma patient (adult and pediatric)

The Workshop focuses techniques of management, immobilization, extrication and transport of a trauma patient. This will be an almost entirely practical workshop. For 30 Volunteers.
