Information

- Each team should consist of three members and one alternate. All team members are required to be current ITLS-certified providers or instructors.
- All team members are required to be registered for the conference.
- Application will be made for CECBEMS continuing education hours for competitors.
- Jump bags will be provided, and all necessary large equipment to manage the patient will be available on-site. Participants should supply their own personal items such as stethoscopes, scissor pouches, goggles or glasses, and gloves.
- Each team will have an opportunity to review and familiarize themselves with the equipment available prior to the scenario.
- Competition results will be announced during the Awards Ceremony at the conference.
- The winning team will be awarded complimentary registration to the 2015 conference.
- Please submit requests for additional equipment in writing no later than Monday, October 7, 2014.
- Space is limited. Teams will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
