

Board of Directors Candidate Qualifications – 2019

Description:

In this role, you will provide organizational management and oversight, demonstrating a commitment to excellence at all time for the organization. You will collaborate with other Directors as well as ITLS staff and Committees to establish policies regarding all aspects of the operation of ITLS in accordance with the Bylaws, Articles of Incorporation, and applicable laws. You will work meet the organizational objectives, mission statement, and goals of the ITLS vision statement while developing and implementing strategies to ensure the financial well-being and viability of the organization.

Key Competencies:

Commitment, Strategic Planning, Communication, Policy Implementation, Financial Oversight

Qualifications:

- The candidate should be an active and dependable member of ITLS.
- The candidate should have the support of his or her ITLS Chapter.
- The candidate should be experienced in teaching or coordinating ITLS courses.
- The Board should be comprised of members who represent various regions of the ITLS world.
- The Board should be comprised of members who represent the various professions that teach and coordinate ITLS programs.
- The candidate should have been an active participant in ITLS chapter or regional activities for at least two of the last five years.
- The candidate should have been an active participant in ITLS committees or workgroups for at least two of the last five years.
- The candidate should have demonstrated a high level of motivation in the development of ITLS within the chapter or at the international level.
- The candidate should have demonstrated experience in leadership roles.

Term:

- Shall begin immediately upon election and shall last for a term of 3 years.
- Effective with the 2017 elections, elected Directors are limited to three successive terms.
- In the event of the death or resignation of an elected Director during the term of office, or if the elected Director shall for any reason be unable or unwilling to serve, the Board Chair may appoint a replacement Director until the next Congress when the Congress delegates shall elect a new Director to complete the unexpired term.
