



ITLS HIGH THREAT FOR MILITARY AND CIVILIAN PROVIDERS INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The following are the criteria for attendance at the ITLS High Threat for Military and Civilian Providers Instructor Course in Tampa:

- 1) To qualify as an **ITLS High Threat Senior Instructor** after course completion:
 - a) Must be an ITLS or equivalent, (equivalent means PHTLS, ATLS, TCCC, or TECC instructors who have completed the ITLS Instructor Bridge course)

AND

- b) Must demonstrate Subject Matter Expertise in high-threat medicine, defined as:
 - i) A minimum of 12 months real world operational medical experience within the past 5 years attached to a team operating in a high-threat environment.

An **ITLS High Threat Senior Instructor** card will be awarded to those instructors who meet the above qualifications and successfully complete the High Threat Instructor course.

- 2) To qualify as an **ITLS High Threat Instructor** after course completion:
 - a) Must be ITLS Instructor or equivalent, (equivalent means PHTLS or ATLS instructors who have completed the ITLS Instructor Bridge course) or
 - b) Currently certified TCCC/TECC Instructor

An **ITLS High Threat Instructor** card will be awarded to those instructors who meet the above qualifications and successfully complete the High Threat Instructor course.

Because of space limitations, preference will be given to registrants who meet the criteria for Senior Instructor status.
